How to Apply for a GW4+ NERC funded PhD Studentship at PML

We strongly encourage you to make contact with potential project supervisors before applying and to attend the PML PhD recruitment open day if at all possible. This will allow you to get more information about the PhD project and to make sure it is something you want to pursue.

To apply for a PhD, you will need to submit your full CV and a covering letter indicating why you feel you would be an appropriate PhD student for PML. In addition, you will need to clearly indicate which PhD project(s) you wish to be considered for, using both the project title and project number.

You must also complete an Eligibility Status and Equal Opportunities Form, available from Mrs Elizabeth Hamilton-Matthews (contact details below).

To complete your submission and ensure inclusion in the selection process, PML will need to receive the following:

1. Covering Letter – with Project Title and Number
2. Full CV
3. Two references sent directly or via your submission but signed by the referee across the seal.
4. Eligibility Status and Equal Opportunities Form.

NB – we do not require you to complete an application form.

The final project submission is required by 12 noon on Friday 08 January 2016.

Once your documents have been received your submission will be complete and you will be notified of your progress through the selection process.
